- The goalie can go past half tank and participate in the offense.
- There are changes to the corner throw. You can now shoot, put the ball in play and shoot, or pass.

2. Motion to Approve Minutes of 2021 Spring Meeting. Motion made, seconded, approved.
3. Legislative Proposals
 - a. Expand the number of teams per school in tournaments: The Proposal to allow multiple teams (A&B) in a tournament and have it only count as a single towards the three-tournament limit was discussed. Some questions were asked about players appearing on 2 rosters in the same tournament. It clarified that the intent was to get athletes playing time and agreed that a stipulation that a player could only be on one roster per tournament was in line with the proposal. Motion made, seconded and approved.
4. Finance Report – the financials were discussed, and a report is available upon request. A reminder was given about the Student Coach/Referee Internship Program
5. Team Development Report
 - a. League & Team Changes: COVID made a lot of changes necessary.
 - b. Combined Teams due to COVID – some teams had to be combined to have a viable team. These teams will be allowed to participate in post season for 2 years. Review of the situation will happen next year.

- c. Athlete Inclusivity Program – There are 23 athletes looking to be assigned. The board will follow the ground rules previously established to assign them.
